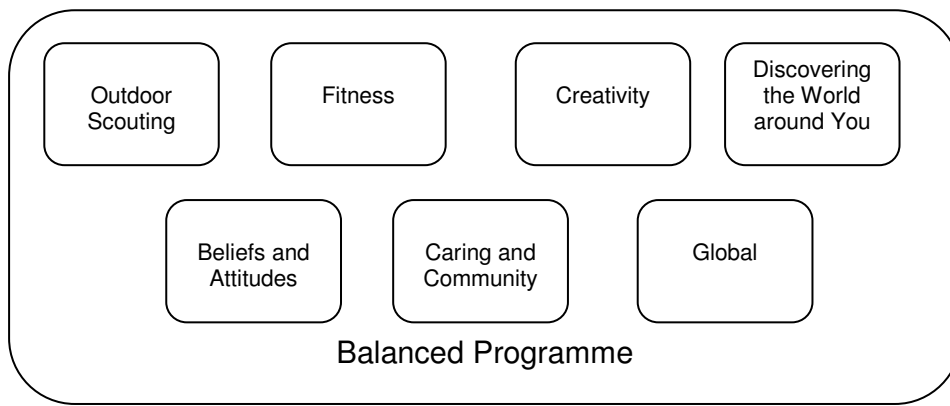
Scout Church Parade – Sunday 29th January
